Adults with a Full Privilege Membership receive the benefit of Kids Korner Babysitting for their dependents while using the facility. Care is available for up to two hours per day, per child at no charge. Our staff is committed to maintaining a safe and fun environment for children. Each staff member is trained in First Aid and certified in infant/child CPR.

Inclement weather: Watch channel 69 (WFMZ), or log on to www.wfmz.com for building delays or closings. Regarding YMCA classes, when the Quakertown School District has a delay or cancellation, Quakertown building classes will begin at 11:00 am and Kids Korner will open at 10:30 am. When conditions worsen throughout the day, check for announcements on the above tv/internet site that will state the time the facilities will close or programs will end. Information will also be available on our website (www.ubymca.org) and Facebook page.

Minimum age: Infants are admitted to the babysitting room starting at 6 weeks of age.

Policies:

To ensure the safety and well-being of your children and to help our staff provide the best babysitting service possible, please adhere to the following policies:

1. For security purposes, please sign your child in and out on the Babysitting sheet.
2. Parents should not enter the gated area.
3. Sick children will not be permitted into the babysitting room.
4. There is a TWO-HOUR TIME LIMIT per day. If you should go over the limit, a \$2.50 late fee will be added for every 15 minutes.
5. Members bringing children other than their own will be charged \$5 per hour per child. Punch cards are available for a reduced hourly rate. Punch card pricing is as follows:

8 hours -	\$20.00
16 hours -	\$28.00
32 hours -	\$40.00
6. Members are not permitted to leave the Y while children are in the care of Kids Korner unless you are participating in an off-site Y program or are walking/running nearby and have left a cell phone number.
7. No food or gum is permitted. Only water is permitted.
8. Members will be called away from their workouts and will need to remove the child from the room for the remainder of the day for the following reasons:
 - A.) The child is crying for more than ten (10) minutes.
 - B.) The child's behavior is unacceptable.
 - C.) The child is sick or hurt.
9. Diaper changing and potty assistance are not done in Kids Korner. Children's diapers should be changed and potty training children should use the the bathroom prior to drop off.
10. Please label all items brought into the babysitting room.
11. We are not responsible for lost or broken items and strongly encourage children to leave electronics at home. All other toys are not permitted.
12. No one is permitted in the babysitting room during closed hours.
- 13. In the event of an evacuation of the Y, the children signed into Kids Korner Room will be evacuated as a group to the American Legion Parking Lot. Parents are welcome to evacuate with the Kids Korner Room but are asked to remain with the group until a headcount is completed at the American Legion Parking Lot.**
